Virgola Prosecco, Drusian Francesco, Valdobbiadene, Veneto	10 / 38
An elegant estate-bottled sparkling white wine with hints of apple and pear.	
Virgola Spumante Rosato, Drusian Francesco, Valdobbiadene, Veneto	11 / 42
A lovely, light pink sparkling wine made from the Pinot Nero grape with a velvety finish.	
Virgola Vermentino, La Corsa, Toscana 2015	12 / 44
Bright straw yellow color with slight minerality that fades into a smooth, orange blossom aftertaste.	
Virgola Rosato, La Corsa, Toscana 2015	12 / 44
A Tuscan rosato produced from Sangiovese & Teroldego. Flavors of wild strawberry & pomegranate.	
Virgola Sangiovese, La Corsa, Toscana 2014	14 / 52
Ruby red color, emanates aromas of flower and fruit, Mediterranean ripe cherries & blackberries.	

BIANCHI

Trebbiano d'Abruzzo DOC, Fantini, Abruzzo 2014	8.5 / 32.5
Fruity with notes of peach, white flower, orange, and lemon blossoms.	
Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, Più Gioa, Friuli 2015	9 / 35
Pleasant floral and fruity aromas of apple, apricot and pear. Distinct and balanced.	
Greco-Fiano "Pipoli", Vignetti del Vulture, Basilicata 2014	10 / 38
Fresh floral and spicy notes. Noted minerality that interacts in an intriguing manner with a slightly sweet finish.	
Arneis DOC, Cascina Bongiovanni, Piemonte 2015	11 / 42
From the ancient native grape Arneis, this wine is dry, expertly balanced, and fuller bodied.	
Vernaccia di San Gimignano DOCG, Pietrafitta, Toscana 2014	12 / 45
Fresh and fruity, but exhibits the full-bodied character associated with the Vernaccia grape.	

ROSATI

Cerasuolo d'Abruzzo, Fantini, Abruzzo 2015	10 / 38
Bright pink in color, intense and persistent aroma, fruity with hints of strawberry.	

ROSSI

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Fantini, Abruzzo 2014	9 / 35
Bouquet is fruity and reminiscent of cherries, and plums with vanilla nuances.	
Nero d'Avola, Zabu, Sicilia 2013	10.50 / 40
Intense aromas of juicy red fruit and balsamic with a long-lasting finish and an aftertaste of woodland flowers.	
Chianti Colli Senesi DOCG, Pietrafitta, Toscana 2011	11 / 42
Easy to drink yet with the complexity and structure of the Sangiovese grapes that were grown in the hills of Siena.	
Dolcetto di Dogliani DOCG, Poderi Luigi Einaudi, Piemonte 2013	12 / 45
Ruby red in color, full bodied with a pleasantly tannic and acidic taste that finishes with a slight almond note.	
Aglianico del Vulture, Pipoli, Basilicata 2013	13 / 48
Dominant flavors of cherry, candied fruit, aromatic herbs. Finishes with elegant undertones of spices and cream.	
Chianti Classico Riserva DOCG, San Felice, Toscana 2011	75
Produced from the best selected Sangiovese grapes in the Classico region of Chianti. Aged for two years in oak.	
Barolo DOCG, Reversanti, Piemonte 2011	90
Bouquet features and intense harmony of licorice, rose, and tobacco. Aged for three years in oak.	
Amarone della Valpolicella DOC, Speri, Veneto 2011	175
Deep in color and all encompassing to the palate. Grapes are dried for 100 days and the wine is aged for three years.	

DOLCI

Moscato d'Asti DOCG, Luccio, Piemonte 2015	9 / 35
Fresh, bright, sweet, and delicate with a slight effervescence.	
Sangue di Giuda DOC, Cantina di Casteggio, Lombardia 2014	10 / 38
Ruby red in color, characteristic perfume of bing cherry. Fizzy, sweet and refreshing.
